

DRESS CODE AND UNIFORM POLICY

Students are expected to be neat, clean, and appropriately dressed each day. The purpose of the dress code is to promote a safe, respectful, and distraction-free learning environment.

Uniform Requirements

Fall/Winter Uniform

- Official school polo with the school logo, or white oxford shirt (tie is required with oxford shirt on gentlemen).
- Official school sweater, vest, or quarter-zip.
- Grey uniform pants, or grey skirts.
- Black leggings or tights may be worn only under approved skirts.
- All black shoes (all black dress shoes or sneakers are acceptable). Crocs, sandals, slippers, and slides are unacceptable.

Spring Uniform

- Official school polo shirt with school logo.
- Khaki uniform shorts, light blue skirts, or khaki pants.
- Official school sweaters or quarter zip may be worn as needed.
- All White sneakers.

General Expectations

- Clothing must fit appropriately and be worn as intended.
- Shirts must remain tucked.
- Pants and shorts must be worn on the waist.
- Clothing must be free of holes, rips, or excessive fraying.
- Undergarments should not be visible.
- Skirts should be worn with hem no more than 2" above the knee.

Grooming

Students should maintain personal hygiene and wear hairstyles that do not interfere with safety or learning. Hair color and style are a family choice provided they do not create a substantial disruption to the educational environment. Young men should be clean shaven.

The administration reserves the right to determine whether attire is appropriate for school and may require students to change clothing that does not meet these expectations.

Accessories

- Small earrings and simple jewelry are permitted.
- Smartwatches may be worn in accordance with the school's technology policy.
